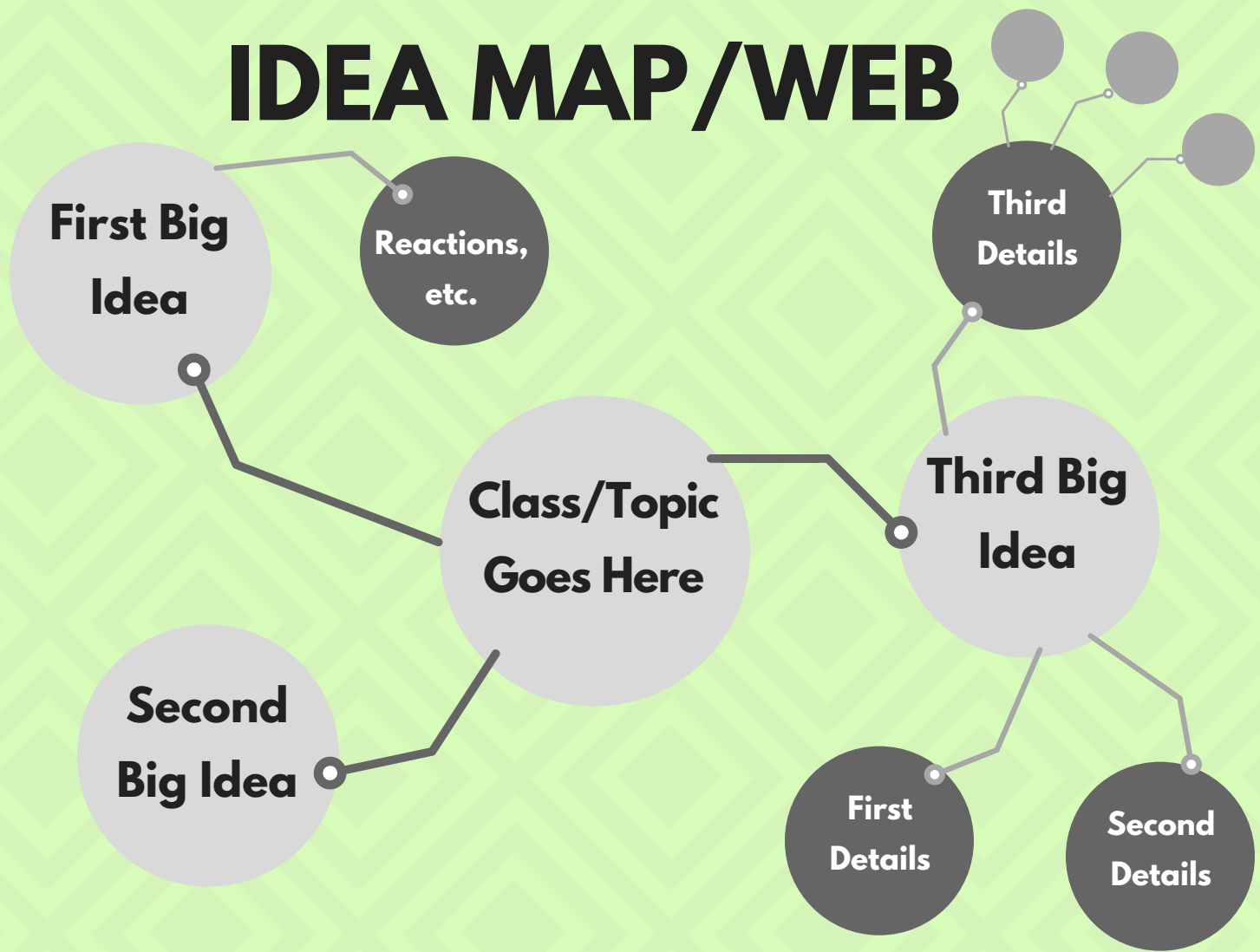

Cons: Difficult to make in class, better for review than in class, requires a lot of space -- so many more organized students don't like it
